RULES: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS), as modified by Appendix E regarding radio sailing, the Sailing Instructions, and class rules. Boats may be subjected to inspection by the race committee at registration or thereafter, per class rule (A8).

ELIGIBILITY: The Competition is open to all DF95 class compliant boats. Boats shall be properly registered with an issued four digit sail number from the DF95 Class Owners Association.

REGISTRATION and FEES: Entries will be limited to 24 skippers and will be taken on a first come, first served basis. Fees are \$10.00 per event. Pre-registration for all events a skipper is planning to attend is suggested. However, registration on the day of the event is allowed if there are slots available.

SCORING: The regatta will be fleet racing scored with the Low Point Scoring system as set forth in Appendix A of the RRS.
